

GSA Rate Schedule Summary

Effective January 1, 2020

Availability

This rate is available for customers with metered or contract demand less than 5,000 kW for electric service to commercial, industrial, and governmental customers, and to institutional customers including, without limitation, churches, clubs, fraternities, orphanages, nursing homes, rooming or boarding houses, and like customers. This rate shall also apply to customers to whom service is not available under any other resale rate schedule.

Base Electric Charges

GSA-1

If the customer's highest billing demand during the latest 12-month period is not more than 50 kW and the customer's monthly energy usage for any month during this period do not exceed 15,000 kWh.

Monthly Customer Charge: \$15.90 per account
Monthly Energy Usage Charge: 9.657¢ per kWh*

GSA-2

If the customer's highest billing demand during the latest 12-month period is greater than 50 kW but not more than 1,000 kW or the customer's billing demand is less than 50 kW and its energy usage for any month during such period exceed 15,000 kWh.

Monthly Customer Charge: \$15.90 per account
Monthly Demand Charge: First 50 kW – no charge
Over 50kW – \$16.35 per kW
Monthly Energy Usage Charge: First 15,000 kWh – 9.657¢ per kWh*
Additional kWh over 15,000 – 4.067¢ per kWh*

GSA-3

If the higher of the customer's currently effective contract demand or its highest billing demand during the latest 12-month period is greater than 1,000 kW, but not more than 5,000 kW and metered maximum demand has exceeded 750 kW at least once. Manufacturers with Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes 20 – 39 can receive a manufacturing credit.

Monthly Customer Charge: \$190.63 per account
Monthly Demand Charge: First 1,000 kW - \$16.30 per kW
Additional kW over 1,000 - \$18.85 per kW
Monthly Energy Usage Charge: 4.067¢ per kWh*
Excess Demand: \$18.85 per kW in excess of the higher of 2,500 kW or contract demand

Manufacturing Credit: For qualified customers, if the monthly metered demand is at least 1,000 kW, but less 5,000 kW, the following credit will apply:

First 1,000 kW x \$1.38 + kW over 1,000 x \$1.63 + all kWh x 1.076¢

Determination of Demand

EPB will meter the demands in kW of all customers having loads in excess of 50 kW. The metered demand for any month shall be:

- (a) the highest average load in kW during any 30-consecutive-minute period of the month
- (b) 85 percent of the load in kVA plus an additional 10 percent for that part of the load over 5,000 kVA
- (c) Not less than 30 percent of the higher of the currently effective contract demand or the highest billing demand established during the preceding 12 months

Minimum Bill

The monthly bill for GSA1 & GSA3 will not be less than the sum of

- (a) The customer charge,
- (b) The demand charge applied to the customer's billing demand,
- (c) The energy charge applied to the customer's energy usage

The monthly bill for GSA2 will not be less than sum of

- (a) The customer charge,
- (b) 20% multiplied by \$16.35 multiplied by the higher of the current effective contract demand or the highest billing demand established during the preceding 12 months

Seasonal Service

Customers may contract for service on a seasonal basis but are limited to 2,500 kW and shall pay the above charges plus an additional seasonal use charge:

GSA1: 1.03¢ per kWh per month

GSA2: 1.03¢ per kWh for the first 15,000 kWh per month and
\$3.09 per kW per month of billing demand in excess of 50 kW

GSA3: \$3.09 per kW per month of billing demand

Contract Requirement

EPB requires contracts for customers whose demand requirements exceed 1,000 kW, these contracts will be for an initial term of 1 year. The customer will contract for its maximum requirements, which will not exceed the amount of power capable of being used, and EPB is not be obligated to supply power in excess of the contracted demand.

Payment

Bills under this rate schedule will be rendered monthly. Any amount of the bill unpaid after the due date specified on the bill may be subject to additional charges under EPB's standard late-payment policy.

Single-Point Delivery

The charges under this rate schedule are based upon the supply of service through a single delivery and metering point at a single voltage.
