

# How to Use Your Unlimited DVR

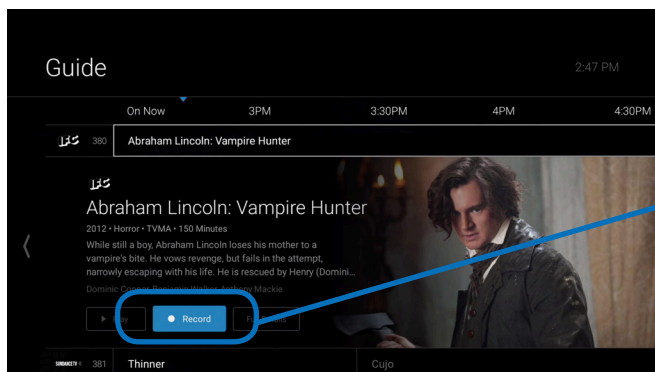
With Fi TV's optional Unlimited DVR, you can record as many shows as you like at the same time without using any of your streams. That means you can record on several channels at the same time and still watch Fi TV on up to 10 streaming devices, depending on your Fi TV plan, while you are recording. **And, recordings remain in your DVR for up to one year.**

## Managing the DVR

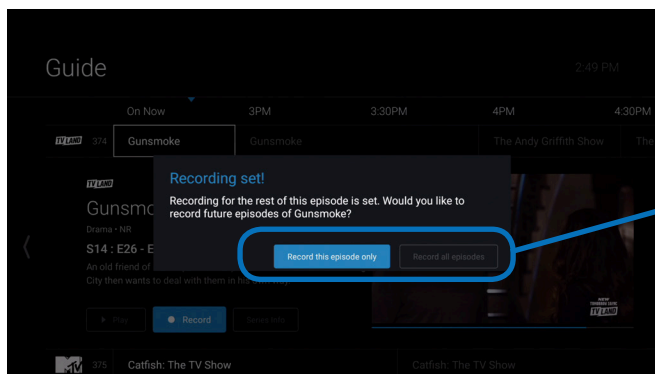


To set a DVR recording, select a listing from the “Shows” or “Movies” listings or use the magnifying glass option to search for a program by title

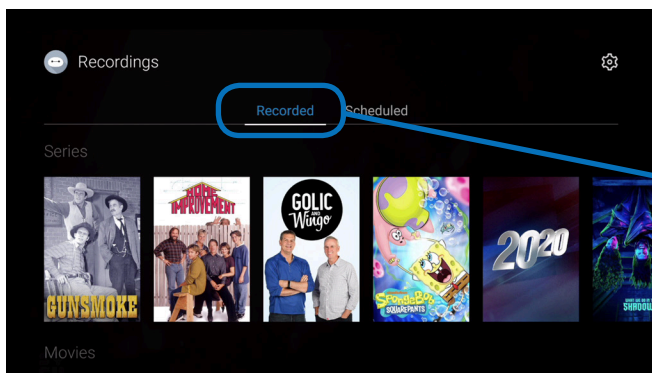
You can also record shows from the “Guide”



For movies, you will have the option of recording the remainder of the movie currently airing or choose a future airing to record

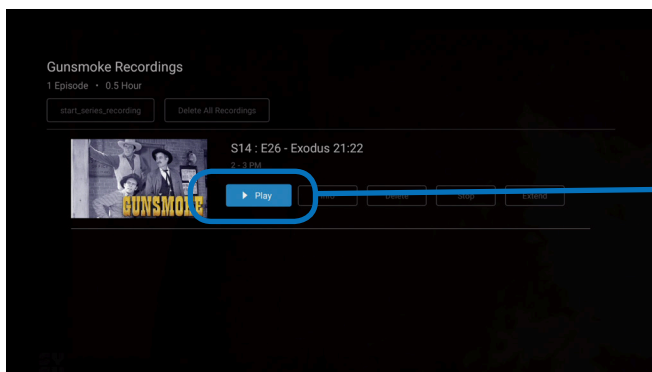


For shows, you have the option of recording just the current episode, or all episodes from any or all channels on which that program airs



You can locate and manage your DVR recordings under your “Profile”

Choose “Recorded” to access all of your recordings



Select a title, then choose from the menu options that appear

To watch recordings on the go, login to your Fi TV account from a streaming device or Web browser. Choose “Recordings” from your Profile just as if you were watching from home.

Keep in mind that every device watching on your Fi TV account, whether at home or away from home, is using a stream.
